BACKGROUND

In November 2018, the Interfaith Alliance for Safer Communities hosted 'Child Dignity in the Digital World' global forum. The first of its kind, it aimed at combatting the online sexual abuse and exploitation of children.

The event was attended by 450+ senior faith leaders and senior representatives from government agencies, technology industry, NGOs and international organizations.

Six regional workshops were also conducted in the run-up to the event across the world, attended by 270+ participants.

The forum concluded with the adoption of the Declaration of Abu Dhabi.



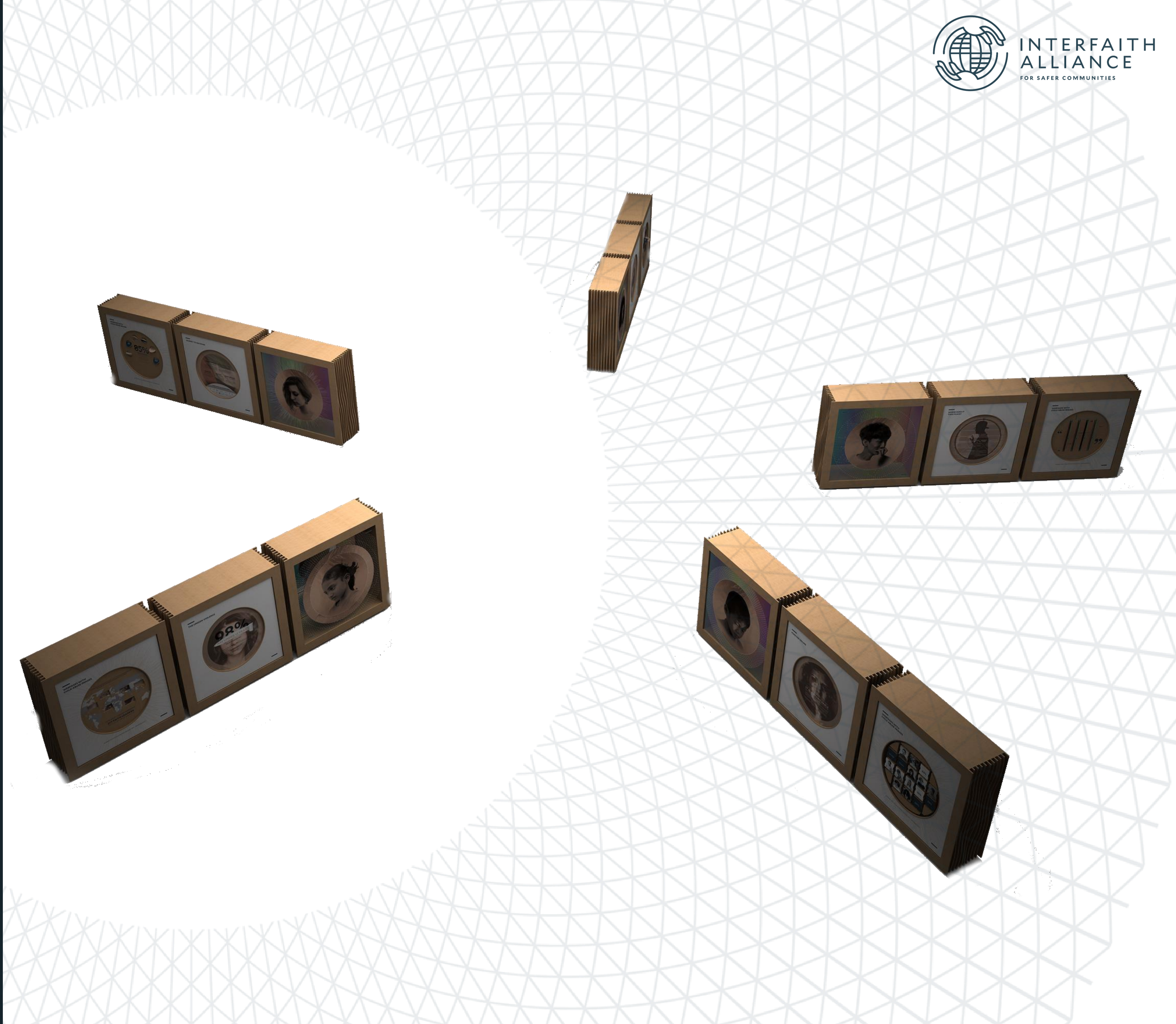
THE EXPOSITION

The Interfaith Alliance Exposition was developed with the goal of providing an interactive yet simple way of communicating the different aspects of online sexual abuse and exploitation of children.

The exposition was unveiled at the Interfaith Alliance forum in Abu Dhabi in November 2018 to an extremely positive response from attendees.

Initially displayed at the Wahat Al Karama in Abu Dhabi, the exposition will be displayed at various locations across the world in coordination with our partners in order to increase global awareness of the risks posed by online sexual abuse and exploitation of children.

The exposition has been designed in a modular manner to enable multiple display configurations.

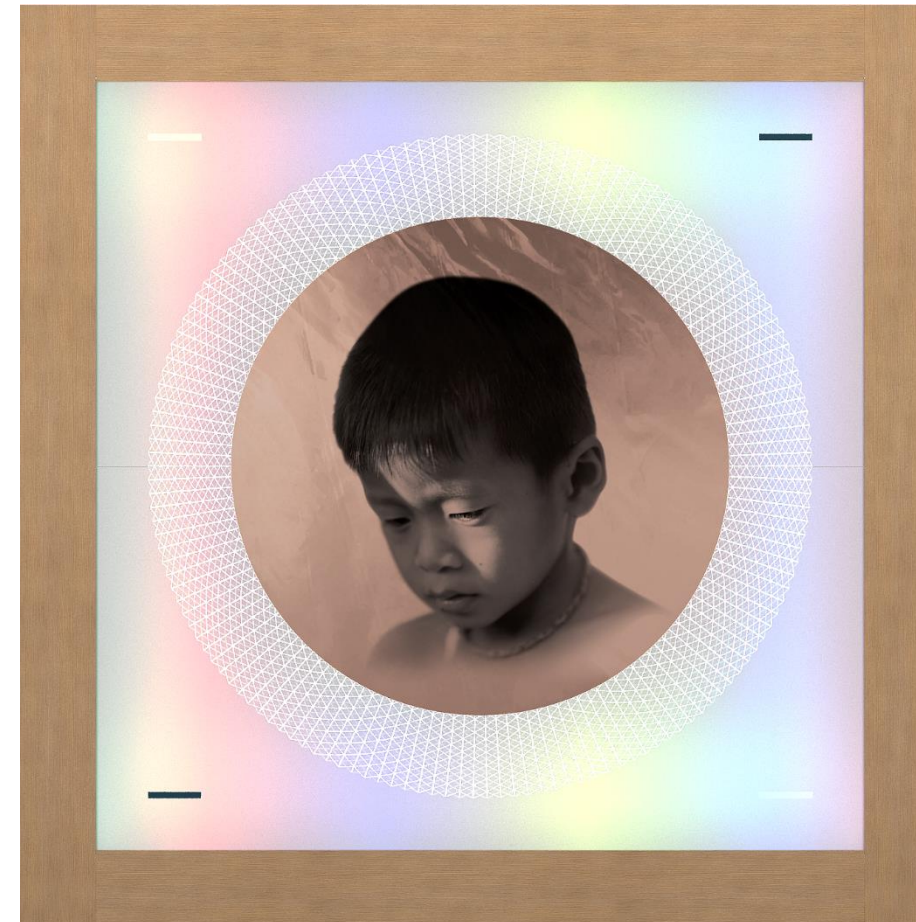
SET 1: WHAT

It provides statistics on online child to viewers on the size of the problem.

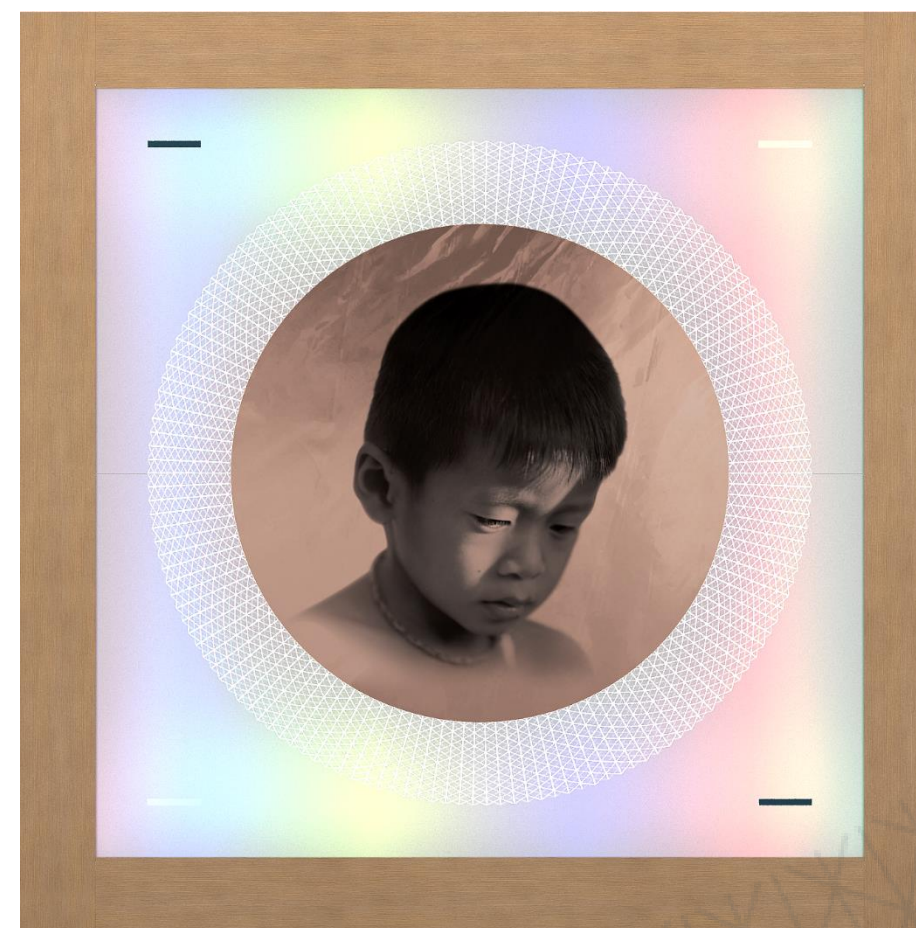

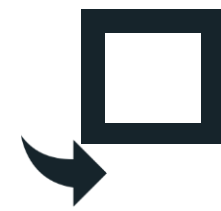

DESIGN, BUILD & TRANSPORTATION

The Interfaith Alliance Exposition has been designed in a modular manner to enable easy assembly, storage and transportation.



Each panel of the exposition contains content on both sides in English



Flight cases have been prepared for each display panel to allow for safe and secure transportation



Designed to be accessible to visitors of all ages with a primary focus on user friendliness.



The IFA Secretariat will cover the costs of transportation and insurance, as well as assembly / dismantling and packing / unpacking



Every interactive element is wheelchair-accessible.



By using sustainable wood throughout the exposition, we have made a conscience decision to ensure that we are environment friendly.



Assembling / dismantling of the exposition will take approximately 1-2 days depending on the availability of manpower and duration of access to the venue.



Panels have been designed to allow for easy assembly, dismantling and transportation



The IFA Secretariat has prepared an instruction manual to allow for easy assembly, dismantling and packing

SPECIFICATIONS



The dimensions of each display panel are 0.8m(D) x 2.4m (W) x 2.4m (H)



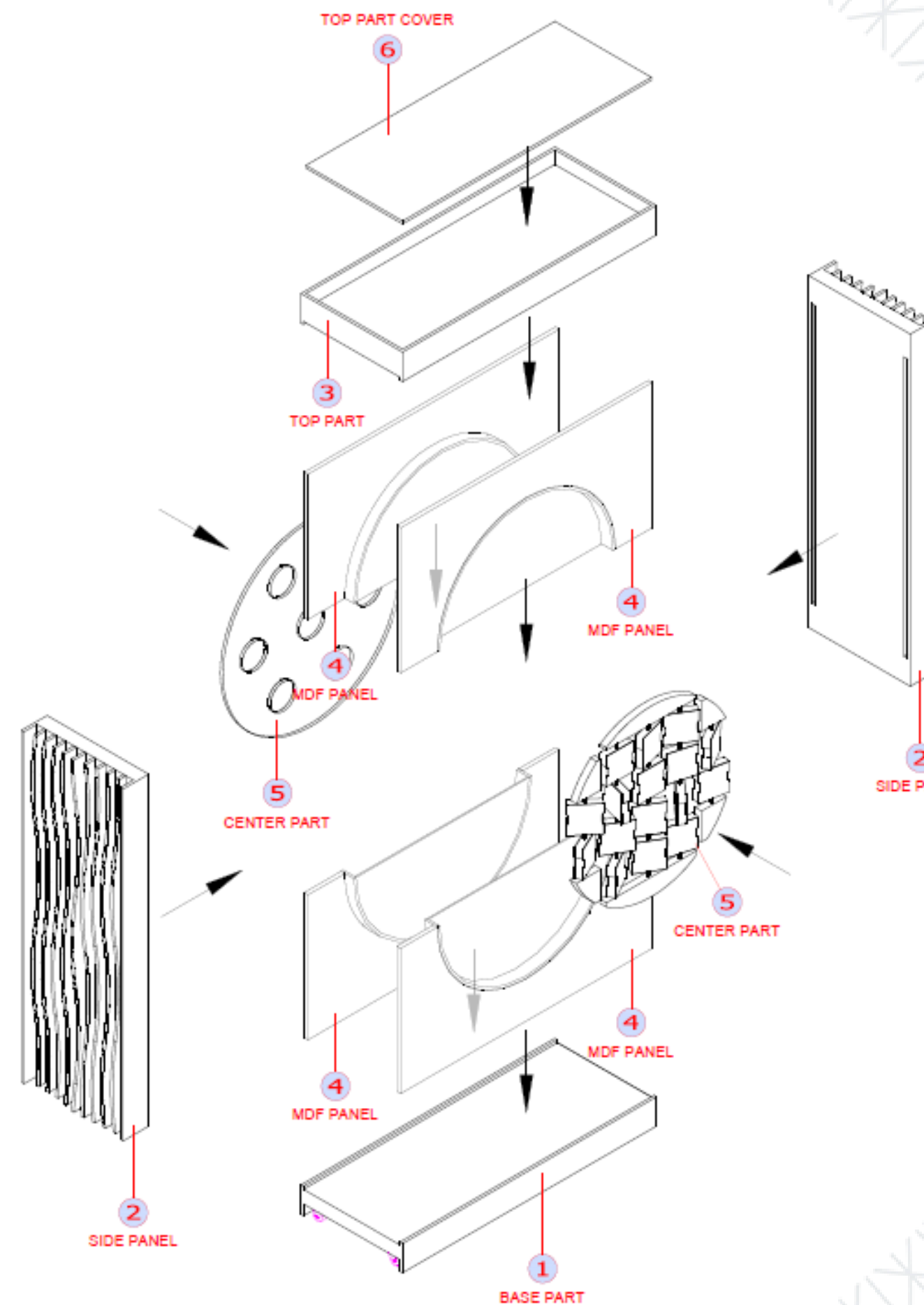
The weight of each panel is 400kg



Minimum display space for one set of panels is 6 sqm, and for all five sets is 50 sqm



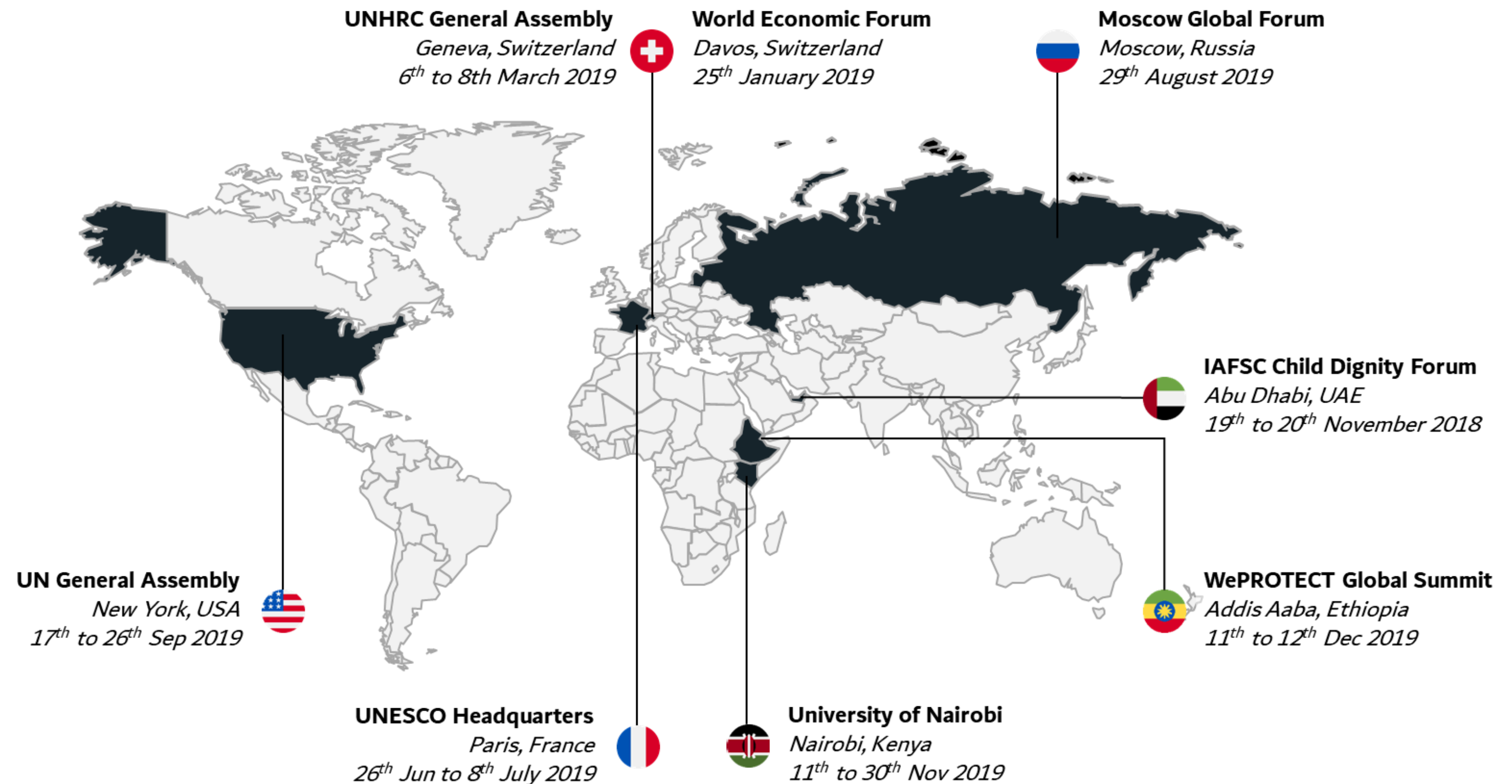
Panels have an in-built battery and will not require electricity connection if displayed for a short duration of time



SCHEDULE

The Interfaith Alliance for Safer Communities Exposition is scheduled to visit 6 countries in 2019. The first stop of the Exposition is at the 40th session of the United Nations Human Rights Council in Geneva in March 2019. On its way to Geneva, the IFA Exposition was displayed at the World Economic Forum 2019 in Davos at an event hosted by the Interfaith Alliance. The exposition next visited UNESCO headquarters in Paris, followed by the Moscow Global Forum in Russia and the Grand Central Terminal in New York. The exposition is currently at the University of Nairobi, and will then head to Addis Ababa for the WePROTECT Global Summit.
